With this program you **may not** be receiving any other STO's. **Scholarships are awarded for a 3 yr. period** and then you must reapply at that time.

Qualified students in 2016-17 received up to \$5200 for K-8th and \$6500 for 9th-12th. **First come, first serve basis.**
